

Information on Awarding Contracts

Contracts for goods and services provided or performed using independent contractor agreements or fee agreements are determined according to the total contract value pursuant to Section 3 of the German ordinance on the award of public contracts (Vergabeverordnung, VgV).

When estimating the total contract value, all anticipated costs for procurement must be added together. This means that all items that generate costs for Universität Hamburg during the contractual period must be taken into account. The value-added tax is not included in this calculation.

Freelance services

As a rule, there must be a call for tenders to award freelance services. As per Section 50 of the German regulations for tenders below the threshold amounts (Unterschwellenvergabeordnung, UVgO), competition must be encouraged as much as possible.

From EUR 50,000	 Discretionary award with at least 3 tenders, or a) performance/provision is particularly <u>urgent</u>; b) the goods/services can <u>only</u> be provided/performed by <u>one</u> <u>specific</u> company; c) there are <u>less than 3 tenders</u>. 	

¹ Circumstances that Universität Hamburg could not have foreseen make performance/provision particularly urgent and the University is <u>not</u> responsible for the reason(s) for the particular urgency.
